Reception Assessment Center (RAC) Announcement January 2015

Our Reception Assessment Center (RAC) program is proud to announce that a new site has been added to the program. RAC sites are located in Bernalillo County at the New Day Safe Home, Valencia County at Century High School, Sandoval County at Bernalillo High School and the Rio Rancho school district located at Rio Rancho High School. The new site is located in the Cuba School District.

RAC is a detention diversion program designed to provide law enforcement an alternative to incarceration for youth who have been detained for low level misdemeanor or felony offenses. RAC seeks to have a positive impact on youth and is intended to ensure that a juvenile and his/her family receive services in a timely, appropriate, effective and coordinated fashion utilizing a strength-based approach. The goal is to intervene swiftly and connect youth and their family to community resources to prevent further involvement with the juvenile justice system.
